DISCIPLINARY RULES

- I. Students admitted to the College / Hostel should strictly observe the disciplinary rules in force in the College / Hostel which may be framed from time to time not-with-standing that these rules are incorporated in the University Regulance or not prescribed by other colleges.
2. Non-Compliance of the rules will be dealt with by the principal in the manner he considers fit and his decision will be final.
3. Students are required to maintain the highest standards of behaviour and discipline both inside and outside the college.
4. Irregular attendance, indifference in regard to class work, tests and examinations, discourtesy towards teachers, insubordination, obscenity in words and action, anti-social activities ate. are liable for disciplinary action which includes expulsion from the college.
5. Attendance at the College functions, Association meetings, College assembly etc. is obligatory to all students.
6. The college property shall be handled with care and nothing shall be done to damage it.
7. Students are strictly prohibited from smoking in the premises of the College, Hostel, play ground and the vicinity of the college.
8. Students who do not live with their parents or guardians must live in the college hostel or lodgings approved by the principal.
9. It is the express aim of the College to keep the students free from party or communal politics. Students should always conform to this objective.
10. Without the permission of the principal, students shall not organise any activity or associate with any group not connected with the college.
11. Without the permission of the principal, students shall not organise any tour, picnic, or outings. Private picnics and tour organised by the students are strictly prohibited.
12. Participation in political organisation or demonstrations or strike of any kind is strictly prohibited. Students indulging in such activities will be summarily dismissed.
13. The principal in consultation with the college council shall have the power to rusticate any student from the College if in the opinion of the council the student is found guilty of serious misconduct or student's presence in the college is injurious to order and discipline.
14. The student's name is liable to be struck off from the rolls of the college whenever he/she is absent from the class for 10 or more days without prior permission from the principal or on non payment of fees within the prescribed dates.
15. Students are warned that they should get a minimum of 75% of the attendance for each subject failing which they will not be eligible to appear for the University Examination.
16. Serious notice will be taken of absence without leave from tests and examination.
17. Students who were absent for the examination partly or fully should apply to the Principal for condition of absence in the prescribed form before they attend further classes.
18. They should also meet the principal along with their parents or guardian and seek his permission to attend further classes.
19. If the absence to the examination is due to ill health, a Medical Certificate from a Doctor approved by the college should be produced in case the Principal or any member of the staff has no personal knowledge of the illness.
20. No. Student shall be allowed to appear for the University Examination unless he /she has secured requisite attendance and his/her progress as well as conduct during the course of the year has been satisfactory.
21. The parent or guardian should look in to the Cumulative Record of the student from time to time and attest statement of marks in respect of the Terminal Examination.
22. Parent or guardians are also requested to keep in touch with Principal from time to time regarding the progress, conduct and attendance of their son/daughter/ward.
23. Admission to the college is made on year to year basis and students are required to apply for admission at the commencement of every Academic year.
24. Students will not be admitted to the college again succeeding year unless their attendance, progress and conduct during the previous year have been satisfactory.
